Honours Program

To enrol in our honours program a degree with a major in Anthropology and a final course mark of at least 65% in Anthropology, is a minimum requirement. The department is also open to accepting candidates with a major in a cognate discipline, with a minimum of 65% in the relevant discipline. To be accepted into our program candidates also need to complete a two to three page concept proposal outlining your proposed research topic that needs to be approved by our Departmental Research Committee.
