- Please note that your planned curriculum may differ from that which is finally approved by the Dean of your faculty. The regulations governing your degree/diploma/certificate may well not permit you to take the combination of courses you list below and you are asked to carefully check the courses listed on your 2011 record when you register, as your proposed choice of courses may have been changed by the Dean.
- If you have not made up your mind on all the courses for which you will be registering, list only those you feel sure you will be taking.
- Please note further that you will **not** be committed to taking any or all of the courses you list below. You may change these courses in consultation with your Dean or, if you are a Humanities or Commerce student, with the staff at the Academic Administration Office. Although all students will be required to register, **some students may be excused from Curriculum Approval:**
 - Commerce and Humanities Faculty students** are asked to check the forms given to them when they register, as they will indicate whether or not the Dean has pre-approved the courses. If approved by the Dean and if you do not intend changing the courses listed on that form, you will not be required to attend curriculum approval. If not approved by the Dean, you will be required to seek curriculum approval on the appropriate curriculum approval day.
 - Education, Law, Pharmacy & Science Faculty students** require curriculum approval from their respective Deans on the appropriate curriculum approval day.
