Honours in Directing affirms the work of the theatre director as a creative artist rather than simply an interpreter of literary texts. The course challenges the perception of the director as one who merely "stages" the playwright's vision. Students are encouraged to explore the elements of the theatre event in such a way that they may be brought to creative fruition, in the crafting and presentation of innovative and challenging theatre. Thus, students are expected to be able to select appropriate resource material and research, analyse and develop this material into an arresting theatrical concept which engages the audience in a sophisticated demonstration of all the elements of performance craft and theatre technique. Finally, students are required to organise, co-ordinate and manage the performance to the level of a professionally performed event. All of this within the time limit of 30 minutes!
