ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS

The loyal financial support from alumni enable the School to award 8-10 scholarships yearly.

The scholarships are created in whatever name the donor wishes, for example the name of a journalist which upholds them in generations to come, an alumnus' parent or relative, even a worthy cause.

Currently we have among other scholarships set up in the name of :

David Rabkin, Steven Hilton-Barber, Ntombana Mnyanda and an ethical journalism scholarship.

In August the scholarships are awarded to the chosen first year students. The winners are selected on the basis of:

- a. Their academic performance during the June exam.
- b. Need for financial assistance .

The money which amounts to R5000 is deposited
