## WHY PERSISTENT IDs?

### Challenges for the **individual**:

- Multiple profile systems
- Manual data entry
- Administrative burden
- No control of personal data
- Name ambiguity
- Recognition/credit

### Challenges for institutions:

- Name ambiguity
- Trust in metadata
- Reporting latency
- Silo systems
- Return on investment
- Discoverability



### WHAT DOES AN ORCID ID DO?

- 1 Enable machine readability
- 2 Disambiguate and enforce uniqueness
- 3 Enable linking and data integration

## **SO CAN WE CLEAN THIS UP?** Of course!

### We need to use **digital names**:

<u>persistent identifiers</u> that uniquely specify the person, organization, or object to which a name refers



### WHAT IS AN ORCID ID?

An ORCID iD is a unique persistent identifier which resolves to data about a researcher. <u>Researchers</u> <u>control data</u> associated with their record.

Organized into two sections.

### **Person:**

Names, Countries, Keywords, Websites, Person Identifiers, Biography

ORCID is an open, non-profit, community-based effort to provide a registry of unique researcher identifiers and a transparent method of linking research activities and outputs to these identifiers. ORCID is unique in its ability to reach across disciplines, research sectors, and national boundaries and its cooperation with other identifier systems.

#### Why use ORCID

As researchers and scholars, you face the ongoing challenge of distinguishing your research activities from those of others with similar names. You need to be able to easily and uniquely attach your identity to research objects such as datasets, equipment, articles, media stories, citations, experiments, patents, and notebooks. As you collaborate across disciplines, institutions and borders, you must interact with an increasing number and diversity of research information systems. Entering data over and over again can be time-consuming, and often frustrating.

Mandating the use of Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID) by submitting authors.

ORCID provides a unique identifier for all researchers that can be linked to their different research works and activities across multiple platforms. It also serves to distinguish authors with similar names and simplify searching of publications databases (such as PubMed, Scopus, etc.) to avoid retrieving articles by authors with similar names. Close to 1.8 million researchers. have already created their ORCID iD. The service is non-profit and community driven.

From 1 January 2016, we will require the submitting author to provide an ORCID identifier as part of the manuscript submission process. Details of the practicalities will be provided shortly, but don't worry, it takes less than a minute to register for an ORCID iD and it's free of charge. A recent survey carried out by ORCID indicates strong support in the research community for mandates by publishers, funders, and universities.
