Various Models:

1. Non-Linear Access Model (set to Read Online for Rhodes)

Under this model, titles may be lent to any number of patrons concurrently. The number of days used for each loan instance is subtracted from the total number of annual loan days set for the title- usually between 225 and 325 (see the order record on Sierra to find out what the instances are per book title) a

For example, if 4 patrons each trigger a 1 day loan for the same title, 4 days are deducted from the 225/325 loan days. This will display as 221/225 and you have 221 total loan days left. The combined number of loan days cannot exceed the annual loan days in a year. Loan days renew on the anniversary of purchase, at no additional cost.

Trigger Events

When a patron uses a Non-Linear book sufficiently (see the trigger events) it counts a loan (or duration of use deduction) against the book.

Trigger Events:

- Viewing the book for more that 5 minutes
- Copy
- Print
- Download a page-range or chapter
- Full-download

2. 1 user access model:

One person can access the book at a time. Download days have been set to zero. Chapter downloads are available even if full download has been disabled.

3. 3 user access model:

Restricts access to 3 concurrent users. Download days have been set to zero. Chapter downloads are available even if full download has been disabled.
