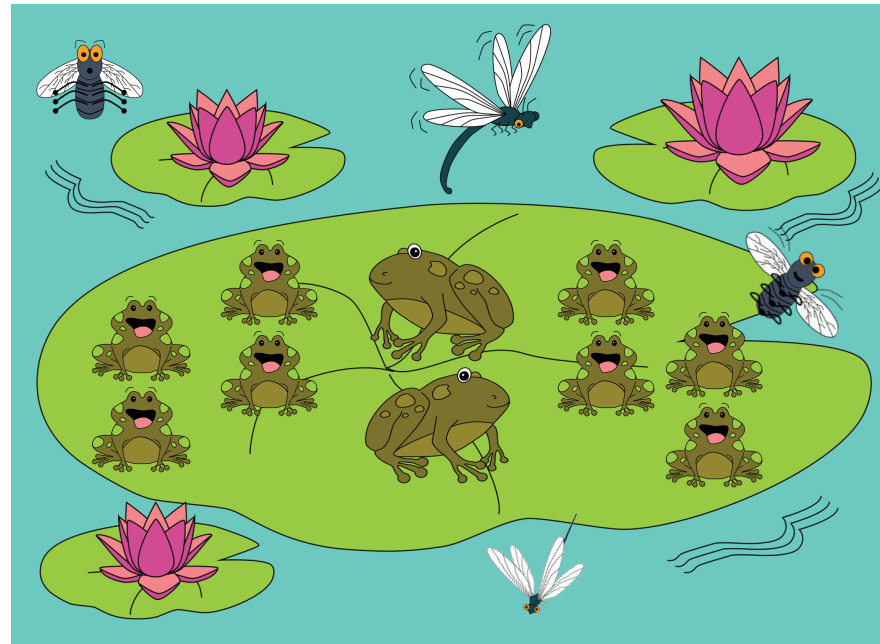

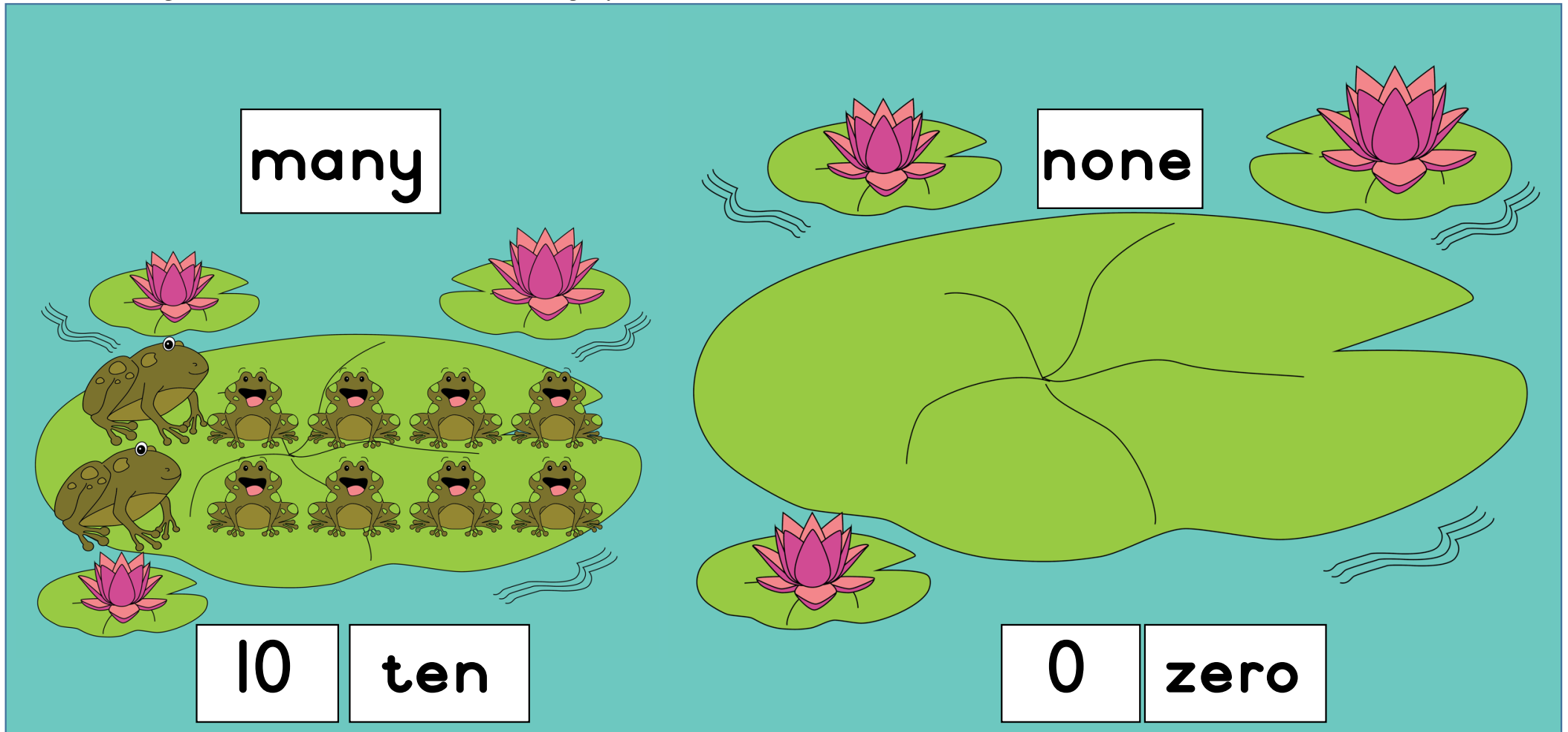

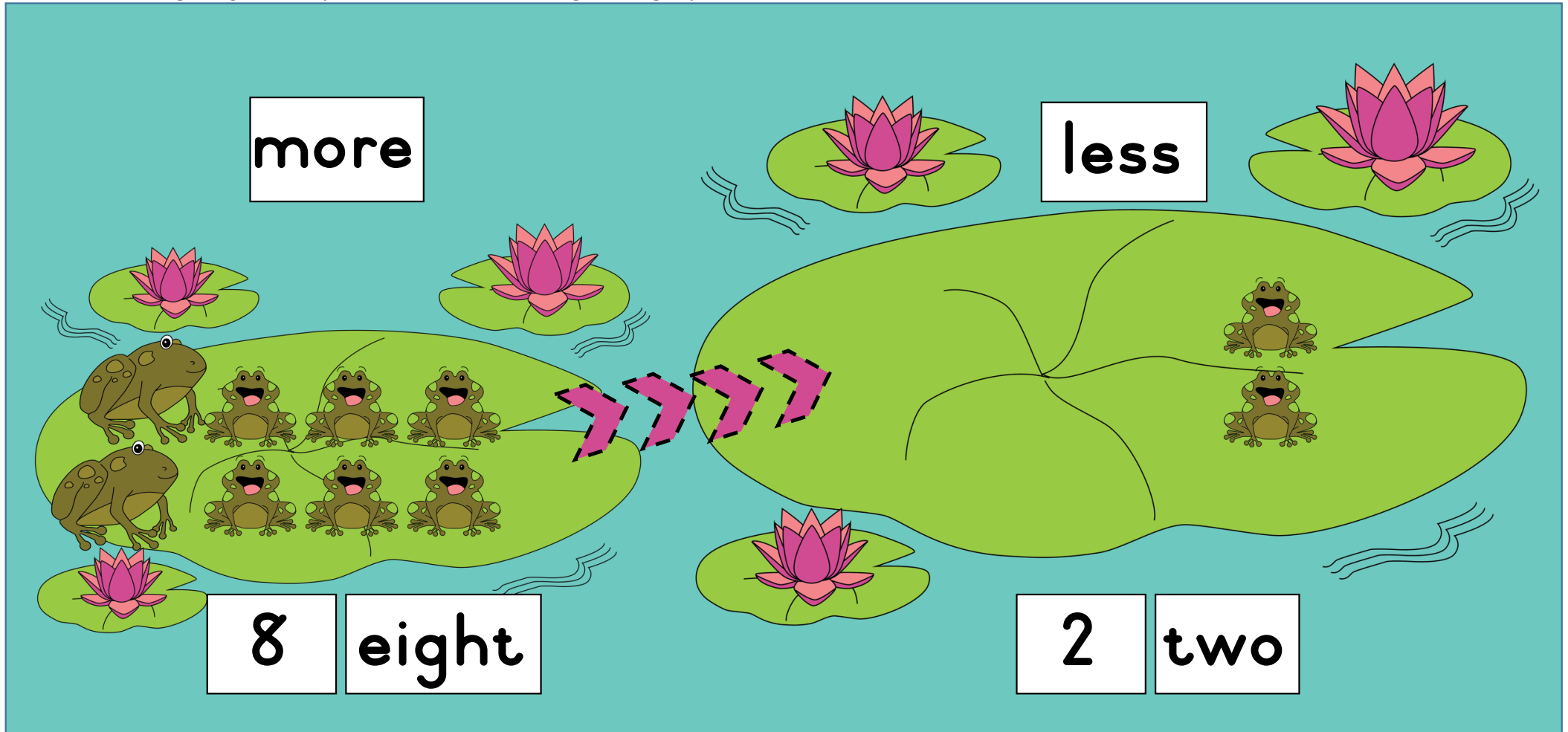
Ten frogs on the small lily pad.



Freddie and Fezi are bossy frogs. They tell two frogs to jump to the big lily pad.

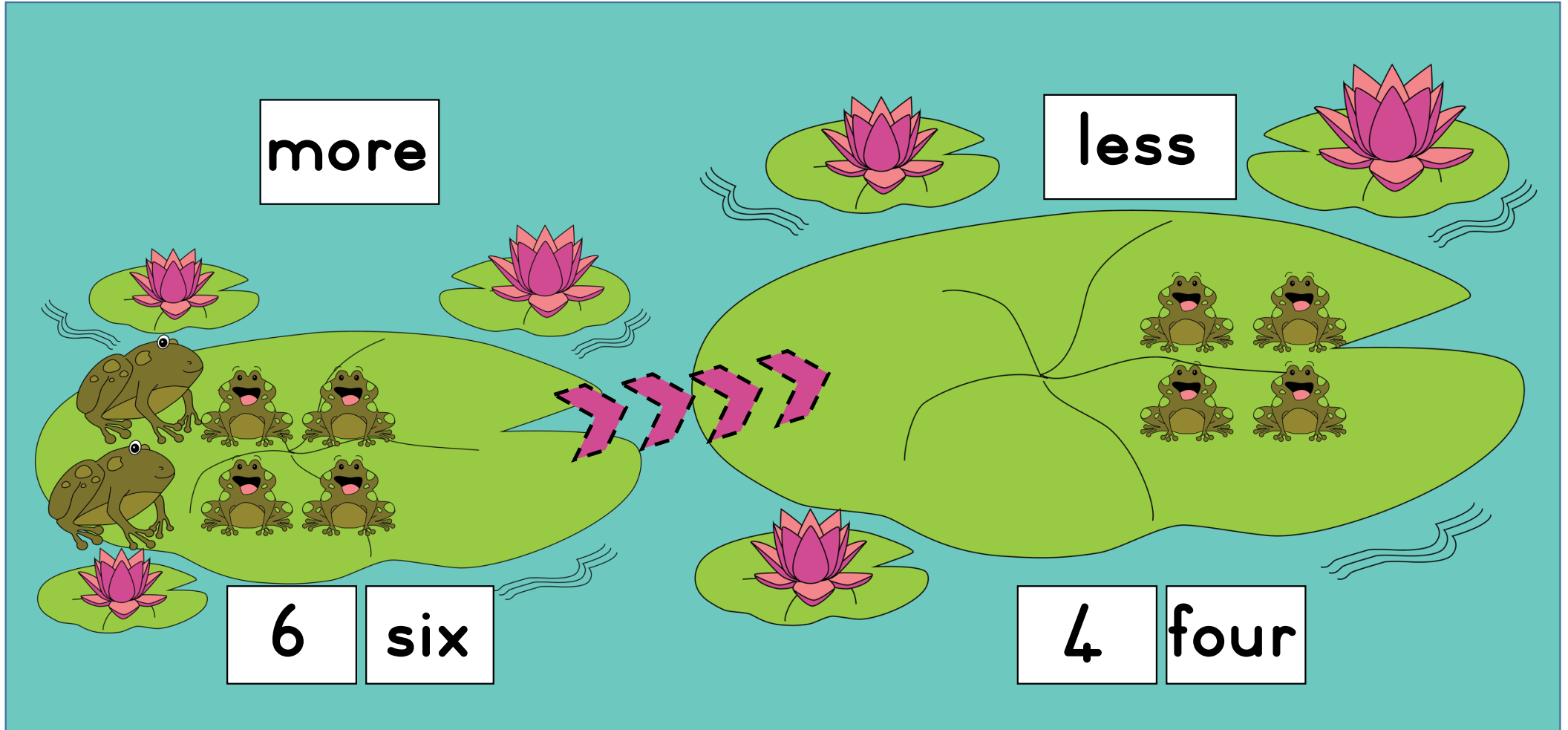

Two frogs jump to the big lily pad.



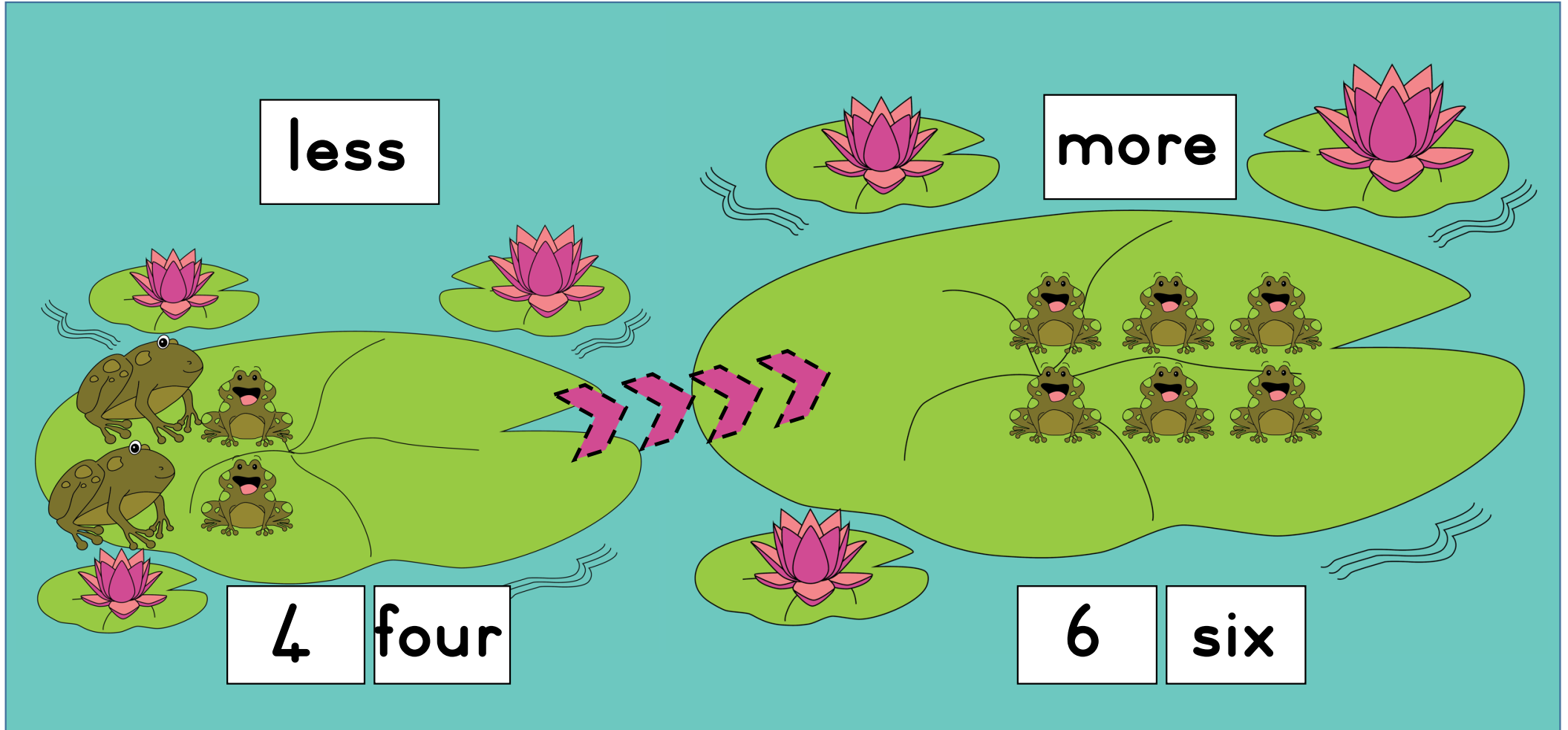

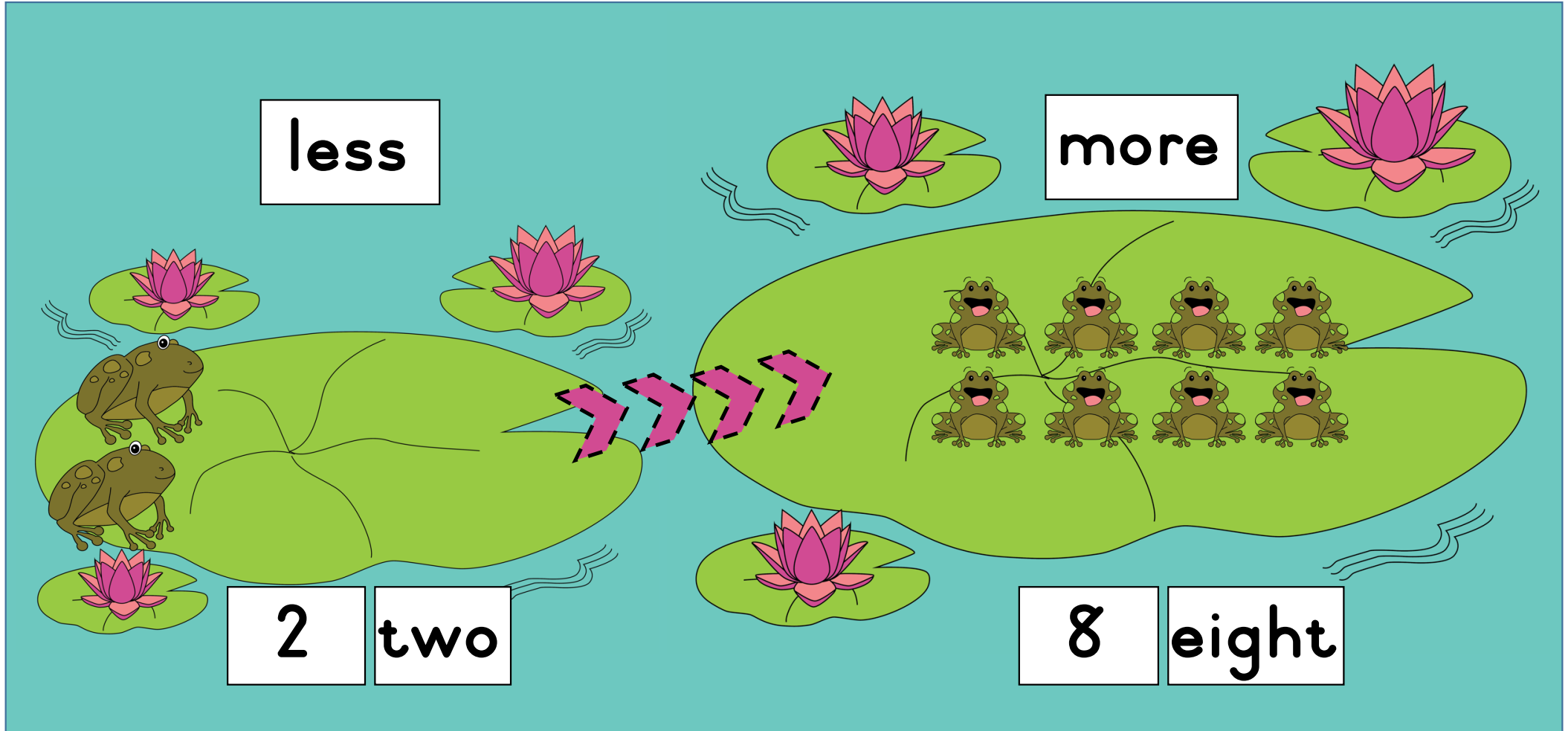

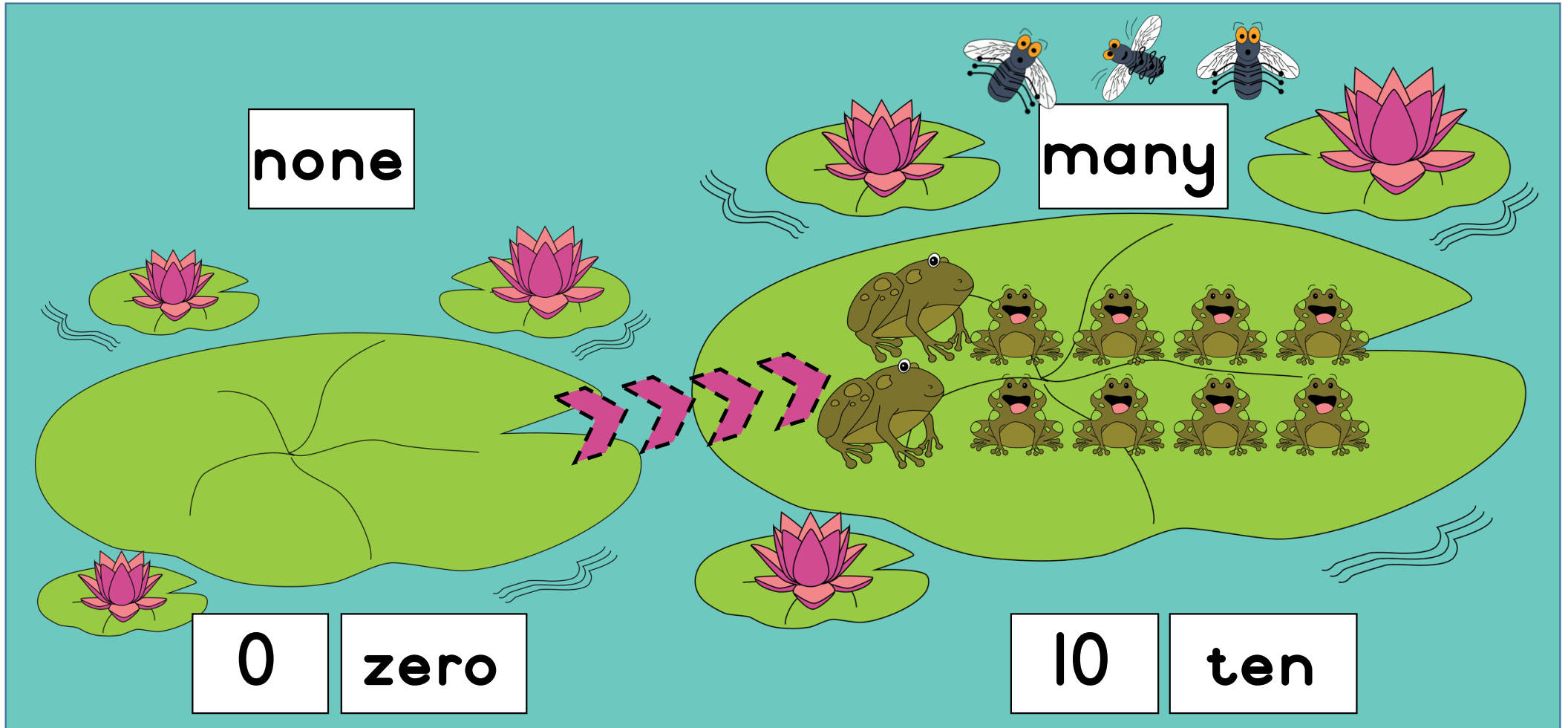

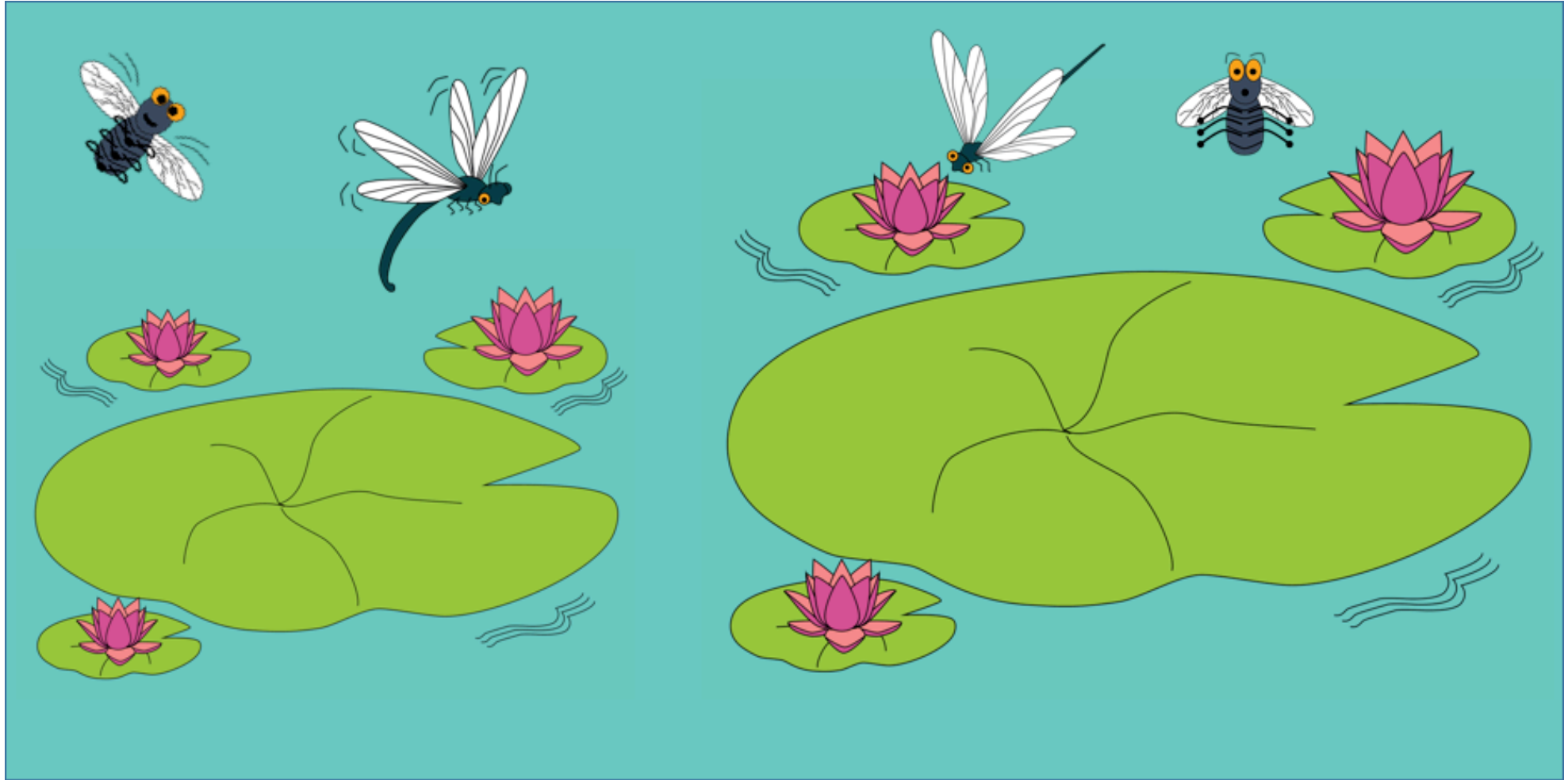
Freddie and Fezi do not like being by themselves on the lily pad. The eight frogs on the big lily pad say "Come and join us." What do you think will happen next?

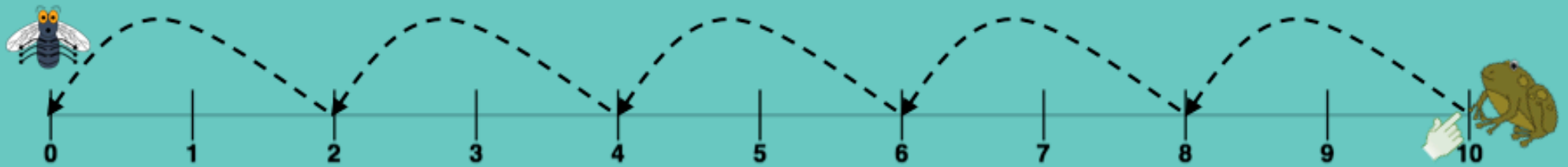
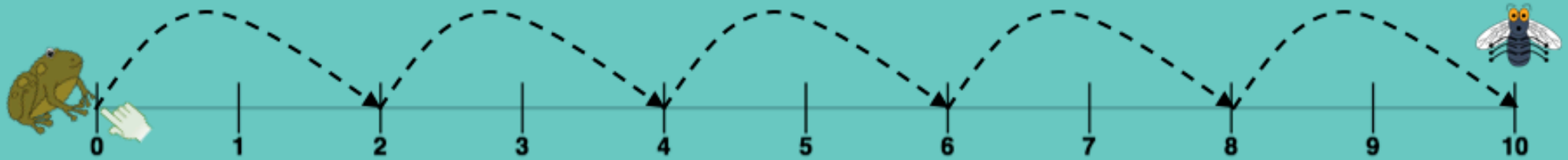
