## Objective

- TERMINALFOUR Site Manager allows you to change the order in which the sections appear on your site structure.
- By default, sections of your site structure appear in the order in which they were created.
- At times, you would want the sections to have a particular order based on your needs.



You can re-order your menus using the subsection ordering?

## Section ordering

Locate the section whose sub-sections you want to reorder, then on "Actions" menu select "Edit section": (*see fig. 1*)

The next dialog box will be "**General section details**", with a tabbed menu. The last option of the tabbed menu, named "**More**", is a drop down with a "**Subsections**" option: (**see fig. 2**)

Clicking on the "**subsections**" option will reveal a list of the current section's subsections as shown on **figure 3**: (*if you have more than 10 subsections, you can use the* **Display** *toggle to change the number of records displayed*)
