The Return of Ex-Servicemen and Women

In 1945, there were 784 students on the College roll. The following year the number had increased to 1189, of whom 484 were 'ex-service'. Accommodation had to be found for this sudden influx and fortunately permission was granted to house 300 ex-servicemen at the abandoned Empire Training Scheme Unit on the Craddock Road. They were transported on troop carriers to campus.



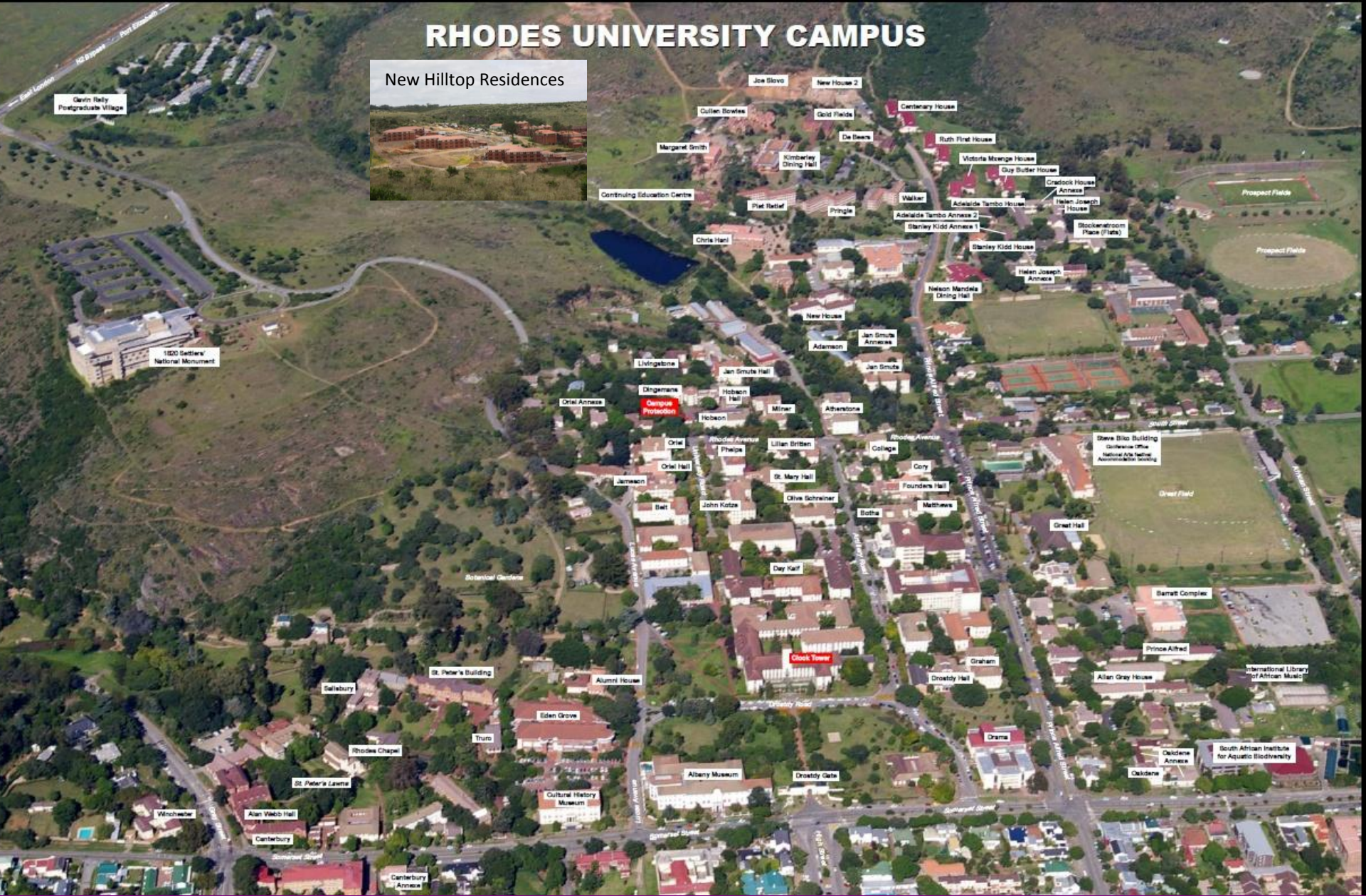

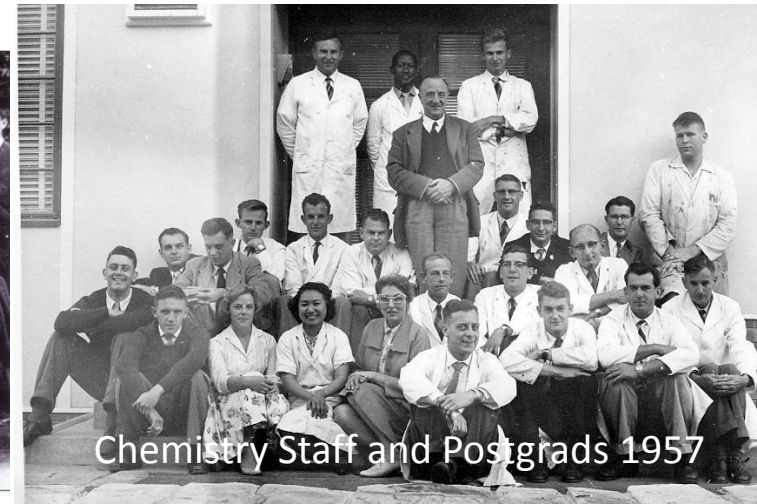

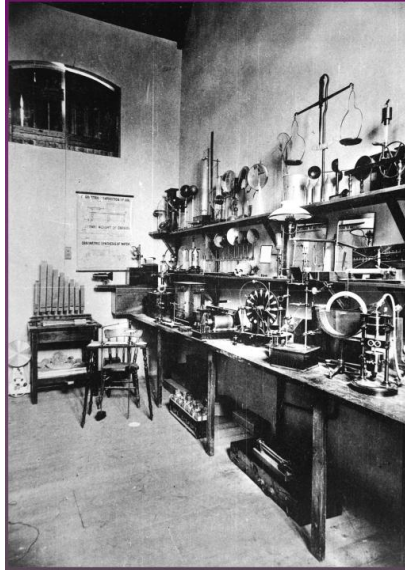

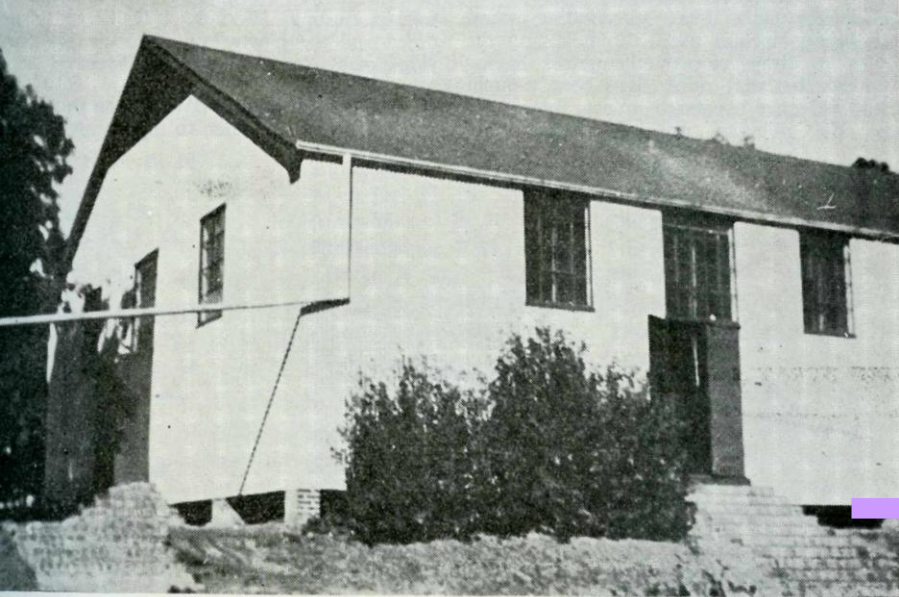

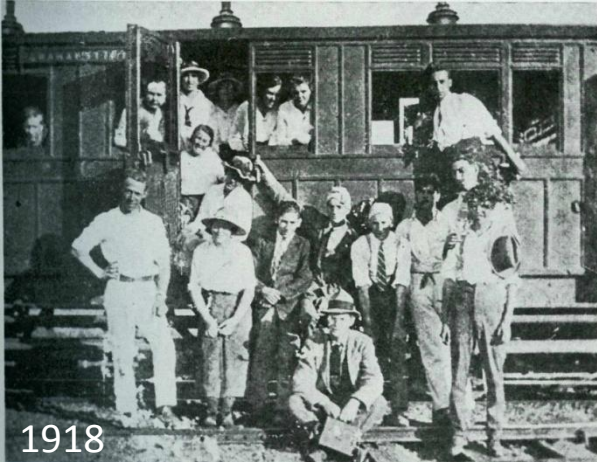
