#### Objective

- To juxtapose the new and the old version of terminalFour
- To highlight the changes in the new version
- To serve as an orientation to the new TerminalFour version

The TerminalFour Content Management system, (referred to T4 CMS onwards), has undergone a major change from version 7 to version 8. The most noticeable would be the colour scheme.

Version 7 had a red dominant theme with charcoal highlights on its header. Version 8, has completely done away with the red header and replaced it with a charcoal header. This is the most obvious and the least significant change, but there are other significant changes which will be dealt with below.

• On Version 7, there was an option for selecting the type of user under the "advanced button". Authentication to TerminalFour is automated through LDAP, meaning your official

credentials should automatically work when you are given access. However, there are few occasions that necessitate the allocation of user locally. These locally created user would have to select a group that the belong to manually, from the list under the 'Advanced' dropdown menu

- Version 8 has done away with that step, and can identify the group which the account belongs to, automatically.
- Version 8 also comes with a more vibrant looking interface for the login dialog. The interface has a darker colour and an interactive background. If you move your mouse pointer around you should see some movements in the screen

## Welcome /Home Screen

- One of the changes that users are likely to notice, is the redirect after logging in.
- On version 7 you would normally be redirected to your site structure




Figure 2: Showing the version 7 vs version 8 landing pages

- However, on version you are redirected to a welcome page (see **figure 2**)

• To access your site structure, you will have to click the site structure button on the right of the screen




Figure 3: Locating the site structure on version 8

#### Primary navigation (Main menu)

- The main navigation menu on version 7, was at the top with dark background with white text.





Figure 4: The old and the new navigation menus

- In version 8, this becomes a collapsible menu on the side with light coloured background with lightweight dark text (see **figure 4**)

## Top "Tool bar" Menu

- There's another menu bar located at the top right side of the screen.
- This menu has white icons on a dark background, version had a similar menu but was hardly used
- This is the menu from which one will access the site structure in version, therefore it is necessary that we explain what each of the icons does



(1) Access the TERMINALFOUR community: To access the TerminalFour forums (Extranet Community), to read up on announcements, releases and new documentation (see below)




Figure 5: What the extranet page would look like

- (2) Language Options: You can either set the system language to English or Español
- **(3) Bookmarks:** If you had bookmarked any pages on your site structure, they would appear here

- (4) Site Structure: This is where you would go, when you want to be taken to the site structure(s) that you have access to.
- (5) Notifications: If you have any notifications, they would appear here

## Mapping the sub-menu of the "Content tab"

- The content menu has sub menu that can be alternatively used to perform some action on the content or sections of your site structure.
- Some of these menu options have changed names, but still do the same action.
- We will then map each of the version 7 sub-menu items to the version 8 menu items




Figure 6: Mapping the Content options from the main navigation

- The yellow dropdown option box now becomes the "actions" on the furthest side
- The content status indicator has taken a more colourful form, instead of having the indicators at the top, the robot colours are in the columns

### **Section Options**




Figure 8: Side-by-side content options comparison, v7 vs v8

- Besides the change in terminology, there's an extra option to expand all subsections of the section you currently "actioning"
- Notable changes:
  - Add Section => Create section for adding a subsection to your site structure
  - o Modify Section => Edit Section for making changes to the section
  - o Add Content => Create content for adding new content to your section
  - o Modify Content => Edit content for making

- The asterix (\*) that indicates that the content is mirrored is replaced by an icon that resembles double squares or a mini-mirror
- The "Actions" drop-down has two extra options for unlocking and locking to bottom. These used to be under a column called "Lock" in this same page




Figure 13: Mapping the elements of Section Information to Section details
