

Objective – Adding videos

- > Located the section you intend to add the video on, on your site structure



How To: Aside videos (YouTube)

1. Locate the “**Aside**” section (or the section you want to upload the video on), and click “**Create Content**” from the dropdown (see fig: 1)
2. Select the template from the list. (see fig. 2)
 - a. If the video will be on your website’s aside choose the “Aside Videos YouTube”
 - b. If the video will appear on the main body of the page, select “Videos YouTube”
3. Enter the **name** of the video, ideally the same name as a heading
4. Enter the “**Heading**”, as already indicated, this should be the same as the **name**
5. Add the last part of the YouTube **video URL**,
 - a. e.g. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=b7c5OuN8cXA>
 - b. OR <https://youtu.be/b7c5OuN8cXA>
 - c. i.e. the part after the “=” sign or the last “/”
6. Click “**Save changes and Approve**”

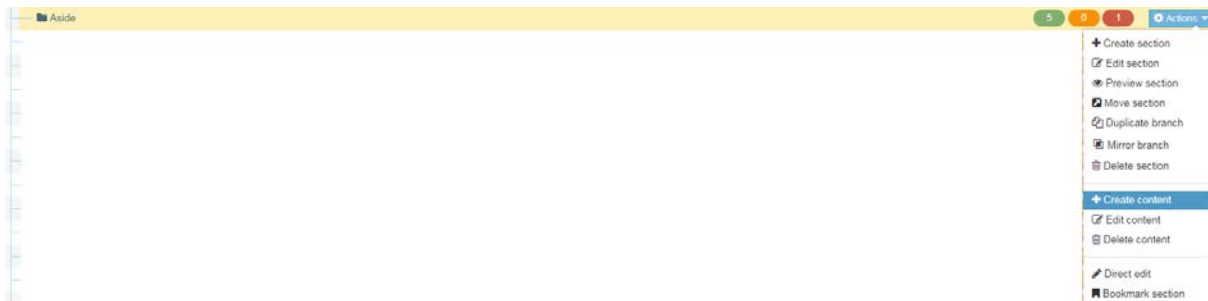


Figure 1: Adding content to a section

1. Locate the “**Aside**” section, and click “**Create Content**” from the dropdown(see fig: 1)

3. Enter the **name** of the video, ideally the same name as a heading
4. Enter the “**Heading**”, as already indicated, this should be the same as the **name**
5. Add the last part of the Vimeo **video URL**,
 - a. e.g. <https://player.vimeo.com/video/222002642>
 - b. i.e. the part after the last “/”
6. Click “**Save changes and Approve**”
