Certificate in Sustainability Law

NQF Level: 9

Dates: 29 September – 2 October 2017



1. INTRODUCTION

The course examines strategic, governance, policy and legal approaches to deal with South African and global sustainability concerns. The course provides business opportunity to engage with the challenges of sustainability, sustainable development and environmental management within a developmental agenda context. More specifically, the course examines some of the fundamental principles of sustainability, the relevant governance framework (international and national) and the relevant policy and legal framework, especially at a national level. The course provides a working knowledge of which is needed to understand sustainability law and its operation from a business perspective.

2. NQF LEVEL

This course is certificated at **NQF level 9**. A *certificate of competence* will be issued to delegates who pass the required assessment at this level. *Letters of attendance* will be issued to those who do not meet the competence requirements. To qualify this course for an MBA credit, all applicable assessments must be successfully complete.

3. ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

All applications will be reviewed by a selection panel. Applicants should **normally**:

- Hold at least a three year bachelors degree or diploma from an approved university, technikon or other institution.
- Have a minimum of 3 years full-time relevant practical business, organisational or environmental consulting experience.
- Be proficient in English.
- No prior knowledge of Environmental Studies is required, but would be beneficial.

4. COURSE OUTCOMES

At the end of the course participants will be able to:

- Understand the meaning of sustainability especially within a compliance and management context
- Understand the national governance, policy and legal framework relevant in terms of sustainability management
- Understand key sustainability law principles
- Identify key sustainability related legislation relevant to businesses
- Understand key tools and approaches to manage compliance with sustainability law \square Understand the key issues related to the enforcement of sustainability law.

5. COURSE CONTENT

This is an MBA-aligned short course, therefore involves intensive sessions where participants will be expected to engage in critical dialogue and actively participate in class discussions and assessment tasks. All MBA class rules and requirements will apply to short course participants, including attendance, assessment, deadlines, etc.





6. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

All participants are expected to bring their own laptops, netbooks or ipad/tablets for use during lectures, as all course materials are provided in electronic format only. Internet access will be an advantage, but not a requirement.

7. COURSE FEE
