CHERTL offers a semester-long series of discussion-based seminars which form part of an accredited tutor development short course, the 2021 *Engage* Certificate in Small Group Facilitation - NQF Level 5.

Who can register for the course?

Only registered RU students who are employed as academic tutors for the duration of the 2021 academic year may join. Tutors from all faculties are eligible. First-time *and* experienced tutors are welcome.

Is there a cost?

No. Participation in this course (as well as course materials) are free-of-charge.

What does the Engage short course consider?

- Getting started with tutoring
- Facilitating groups for engaged learning
- Integrating assessment for learning and teaching
- Engaging with diversity in tutorial spaces
- Feedback and evaluation processes

When does the course take place?

Engage begins in the second week of first term. Thereafter workshops take place fortnightly online, during the first semester. Some sessions will be synchronous, and other activities can be completed in your own time via RUconnected.

Can I achieve a qualification through the Engage course?

Yes. Tutors participating in this course work towards achieving their NQF Level 5 Certificate in Small Group Facilitation.

What will be expected of me?

Successful completion of the Engage course includes -

- Participation in all fortnightly online workshops in terms 1 & 2
- Completion of critically reflective pieces towards a portfolio of work
- Regular journaling about your tutoring experiences
- Interest, energy & involvement

How many places are available?

A maximum of 75 places is available on the course. Tutors work in small groups of 20-25 students. Enrolment works on a 'first come-first served' basis.
