#### INTRODUCTION

This list of accessions represents manuscript material received in the Cory Library for Historical Research during the years 1953-1955. It will be followed at a later date by a further list (No.12) covering printed documents, microfilms, maps and pictures received during the same period.

Ten lists of accessions have previously been issued, covering the period October 1945 to December 1952. Copies of all but the first three are still available.

Entries are listed under signatories in alphabetical order. The abbreviations 8vo, 4to, fcp., and the words "folio" and "elephant" are used somewhat loosely to give a rough indication of size. In addition to the usual bibliographic abbreviations the Library uses "TS" for a typewritten copy, and "PR" for a printed document.

Notable items appearing in this list include: -

- MS 6737, which is the original manuscript of the "Narrative of the war of 1851 and 1853" by Isaiah Staples, of which the Cory Library had previously possessed only a typewritten copy. This is a gift of Mrs. E.L. Morris, a daughter of Isaiah Staples, who retains the right of publication.
- MS 6768-6809, a very important collection of papers which belonged to Sir Benjamin D'Urban, including a large amount of his correspondence and notes. This collection came to the Cory Library from the Estate of Mr. B.A. Steer, through the kindness of Mrs. R.M. Coates, the original owner.
- MS 6891-7082, a large collection of business and financial records, placed in the Cory Library by the Eastern Province Guardian Company.
- MS 6859-6890, papers belonging to the Settler, Thomas Price Adams, including correspondence with various notable people at the Cape, and notes on the many topics in which he was interested. This collection was a gift from Mrs. Rose-Innes, Dr. Turton, Miss Martin and Mrs. van der Vyver.
- MS 6819-6841, 7089-7107, a collection of letters from Robert White to his uncle, Robert Godlonton, presented to the Cory Library by Mr. D.B. Godlonton and Mr. W.A. Godlonton.
