The University Librarian wishes to record most grateful thanks to the members of the Sprigg family for their decision to place this document collection on loan in the Cory Library for Historical Research, and in particular to Mr. J.G. Sprigg, Librarian of the Grahamstown Library, for his most valuable assistance in assembling and listing the documents, and for the foreword which follows.

FOREWORD.

This "collection" is a chance survival. By far the greater part was discovered in a dilapidated and mildewed trunk in a tumble-down woodshed at Cambridge, East London, after the death of my Aunt Jessamy Sprigg. Double chance survival in fact, as I still have a vivid recollection of the fun my cousins, my sister and I had in tending the bonfire that seemed to go on for days in the back garden of Vredenburg, at Wynberg, Cape after the death of my grandfather Sir Gordon Sprigg in 1913, and of later comments on the "frightful accumulation of papers" that had to be "cleared up and burnt." How this trunk with its haphazard contents survived the burning will always remain a mystery. To this basic material I have added . photographs, letters, press cuttings etc. which have come to me variously from my late father and Aunt Jessamy and from my Aunt Lucilla who lives at Betty's Bay.

Like most of these "salvage" collections, the present one tells little about the person concerned, but I have included what personal letters I could find, as well as the notes made by the Rev. Ernest Baker in the early 1930's with a view to compiling a biography of Sir Gordon. Unfortunately Mr. Baker died before he had advanced far with the project.

The Charles Mills letters (which were in the trunk) begin to build up a behind-the-scenes picture of affairs between the governments in Cape Town and London. It is a pity that so many of these letters perished in the bonfire, and sad to think that my childish hands played their part in this.

It has always seemed to me to be a little odd that a man who, in the heyday of the Cape Colony, from the granting of responsible government in 1872 to the time of Union 1910, was called to the the position of Premier no less than four times, should nevertheless have been so studiously ignored by the historians and biographers. Perhaps Sir Gordon really was a rather unimaginative plodder as is sometimes claimed, and he certainly was eclipsed by the glamour of the contemporary names of Rhodes, Jameson, Kruger, Barnato and others, but why, in that case, put him at the head of the state not once but four times, one of these times falling within the critical period of the South African War?

I would like to thank Dr. van der Riet of Rhodes University for his invaluable advice and help in putting the collection together in the first place, and to thank both Dr. van der Riet and the staff of the Cory Library for thoroughly revising my rough preliminary work to bring it into line with the rest of the Cory Library material, and for bringing out this "List of Accessions No. 16", devoted to the collection.

I have much pleasure, on behalf of the family, in handing this collection to Rhodes University on permanent loan to the Cory Library, to be preserved for the future, and to be made available to those who bona fide are seeking information. I hope that the material here presented will be of some assistance to historical research in the general sense, but I cherish also the hope that, meagre as it is, this collection may stimulate someone more competent than I to go to wider sources, and to undertake the rather formidable task of making an assessment of a somewhat neglected character who was prominent in the later stages of the life of the old Cape Colony.
