FOREWORD

REGISTER OF DOCUMENTS NO.32

This issue of the Register of documents lists the documents in the Alexander Kerr collection, the seventh supplement of the Archives of the Methodist Church of Southern Africa, the Archives of the Grahamstown Public Library and the Archives of the Grahamstown Baptist Church.

Alexander Kerr, educationist and churchman, was born in Kilmarnock, Scotland on 20.8.1885. His interest in education was evident from his earliest years as a pupil-teacher in the Highlander's Academy in Greenock. Later he enrolled at Moray House Training College and Edinburgh University, graduating M.A. in 1907. In August 1915 he applied successfully for the post of first Principal of the South African Native College, now the University of Fort Hare. From an initial student intake of 20 pre-matriculants in February 1916, the College grew under Kerr's leadership to a roll of 330 post-matriculant students in 1948, when he retired. Kerr had a profound influence on Black education in Southern Africa reaching far beyond his principalship of Fort Hare, serving on many educational boards and commissions in South and Southern Africa. Kerr was a committed member of the Presbyterian Church of Southern Africa and, in addition to being elected Moderator for 1942-3 though a layman, served on many church committees and commissions. His first wife, Mary Robertson Kerr, died in 1947 leaving two sons, William Findlay and Alastair James. Kerr married Beatrice Dorothy Tooke in 1949. Alexander Kerr died at his home, Moray House in Alice on 21.2.1970.

The Methodist Archives Collection continues to grow steadily but has been augmented extensively recently by the addition of a large body of records (largely church registers) as a result of the comprehensive microfilming project of the South African office of the Genealogical Society of Utah. These records serve not only the needs of the genealogist but are a rich source of South African social history.

Existing sources of Grahamstown local and social history in the Cory Library have been considerably enriched by the deposit of the Archives of the Grahamstown Public Library and of the Grahamstown Baptist Church.

Details of our collections continue to be added to the Library's URICA integrated library system as well as to the National Register of Manuscripts (NAREM) and the National Register of Photographs (NAREF). The third cumulative edition of the published Guide to manuscripts in the Cory Library for Historical Research was published earlier this year and is obtainable from the State Archives Service, P Bag x 236, Pretoria, 0001, South Africa.

The Cory Library offers on-line access to these data-bases and we consider this facility invaluable in our geographically isolated situation.

The Cory Librarian is grateful to the individuals and institutions who have made their collections available for research purposes in the Cory Library.
