The list is an inventory of material arranged alphabetically according to the names of signatories of items, or according to the subjects of maps, pictorial material, etc. Books, pamphlets, periodicals, and newspapers are not included.

The organisation of the papers in Sir G. E. Cory's bequest is being continued by the holder of the Cory Memorial Grant. Among the Cory Collection items which appear in this list, are two sets of papers - those of the Rev. Francis Owen, MS.1111-1129; and those of Joseph Millerd Orpen, MS. 1190-1271. Typescript copies of these sets of papers are now available.
