This list is an inventory of material in the library, arranged alphabetically according to the signatories of manuscripts and printed material, or under catchwords, and according to the subjects of illustrative material. Books, pamphlets, periodicals, and newspapers are not included in this list.

The most important group of documents described in this list, as well as the most numerous, MSS 5820-6010, were given to the university by the late Miss C.W. Price. They include many letters by her mother Elizabeth Lees Price, a daughter of Robert and Mary Moffat of Kuruman, and wife of the Rev. Roger Price of the London Missionary Society, which are being edited for publication by Rhodes University by Una Long. The collection also includes much other related material of great importance, notably letters by Mary Moffat, and printed and pictorial items associated with the letters PR 321-363, and PIC 279-300.

MSS 5640-1 were given by Capt. Guybon C.C. Damant; MSS 5645-5654 by Mr. J. Patten; MSS 5655-6 by Mr. J.H. Shennan; MS 5657 by Mr. Robson Lowe; MS 5658 by Mr. J.C.B. Carter; MS 5659 by Mr. K.H. Bolam. Mias M.F. Fisher has presented MSS 5671-5701, and MS 5793, letters dealing chiefly with the personal affairs of the Webb and Pollard families in the Eastern Cape Province during the nineteenth century. MS 5702, a diary of Henry Hall the geographer, and MSS 5703-5781, letters by Henry Hall his son while in the Colonial Secretary's office at Cape Town, are the gift of Mrs. Richards Williams. MS 5785 was given by Mrs. M.A. Strachan; MS 5786 by Lady Kotze through Prof. Rennie, and MS 5787 by Mrs. van Lingen through Prof. Rousseau. MS 5788 is from Dr. John Hewitt; MS 5789 from Mrs. A.M. Steele, and MSS 5791-2 from Miss Mary Spurling.

MSS 5642-5644, and 5660-5670, presented by Una Long, are transcriptions of historical documents relating to South Africa which were located and copied by her in England.

PR 316 is the gift of Dr. John Hewitt, and PR 318-320 have been presented by Miss Mary Spurling.

PIC 252-265 have been received from Mrs. B.C. Miller; PIC 265-6 from Mr. H.F. Macdonald; PIC 267-9 from Mrs. Eileen Shove; PIC 270 from Dr. John Hewitt; PIC 271-275 from the South African National Society (Eastern Province Branch), and PIC 276-8 from Prof. W.P. Morrell.
