LIST OF ACCESSIONS, No. 9. 1 January to 30 June, 1952.

This list is an inventory of material in the Cory Library, arranged alphabetically according to the signatories of manuscripts and printed items, or under catchwords, and according to the subjects of illustrative material such as pictures and maps. Books, pamphlets, periodicals and newspapers are not included in this list.

MSS 6090 to 6312 were given to the Cory Library by Una Long, lately Field Research Worker in South African History at Rhodes University. Among these are the working notes assembled by her in compiling "An Index to Authors of Unofficial, Privately-owned Manuscripts relating to the History of South Africa, 1812-1920" (Cape Town, 1947), many of which are complete copies of documents only listed or summarised in that publication. Her gift includes also material used in editing "The Chronicle of Jeremiah Goldswain ... " for the Van Riebeeck Society (Nos. 27 and 29, Cape Town, 1946 and 1949), and in advising the organisers of the East London centenary celebrations of 1947 on historical matters, besides detailed records of her work while on the staff of Rhodes University, and the manuscripts of lectures and published articles.

MS 6313, a copy of the Autobiography of Mrs. Martha Jane Kirk (1823-1906), and PIC 331, her portrait, have been presented by her grand-daughter, Mrs. Helen Moroney. MSS 6314 and 6315, two original letters by this pioneer woman, supplementing her formal record of her arduous and adventurous career, form part of a gift of ninety-nine documents, MSS 6313 to 6409, and 6412 to 6414, from Messrs. Espin and Espin, on behalf of Messrs. J.W. and D.R. Dickason, relating to the Webber family, most of them letters addressed to Daniel Webber between 1835 and 1904 by various descendants of Charles and Samuel Webber, who were among "Shepherd's settlers" of 1826. These records relating to Mrs. Kirk and her Webber kin, and her Autobiography, were acquired, from quite different sources, within a period of a few weeks, and the co-incidence is a striking illustration of the way in which scattered items of historical information are often found to belong to an integral whole, and to acquire added interest and importance, when brought together in an organised collection.

MS 6411, a copy of letters written by members of the Southey family between 1820 and 1848, was presented to the library by Mr. R.F. Currey.

PIC 332 to 347 were presented by Mrs. Kathleen Strachan, and PIC 348 by Miss Jessamy Sprigg.

MP 123 was given by Mr. Theodore Mackenzie, and MP 127, 128 and 129 by Una Long. All the other maps and plans described in this list have been purchased by the Cory Library, and are photographic copies of little-known maps which have been sought out in various repositories in South Africa and in England, and assembled for reference purposes.
