

The Pilgrims Progress by Tijo Soga; The translation of the Bible by Bryce Ross; "Yiga ku Yesu" and "Mbuso ka Yama". There are also several pamphlets of some books written up, among them are these "Sizanda Bumnyama" by Wm Anderson Soga^{M.D.}; "Isiyilo sika Hosheha" by Isaac Motaung; "Unkosi wamngamlezo" by Wm N. Bottoman; "Sitimia Ngoku" by Petwill Matshikwe; "Nomogogogo" also "Tjipeli zabantwana" and "Mncedi Wabashumayehi". The above is a lonely lot, yet, there is scarcity of Sicoso books and it is time for them now.

The Story of Kosa Sicoso and of Kosa originally are well preserved although we are English-Kosa today. We have a strong hope that the Sicoso language will not ultimately die out because today it seems a plaything to write in papers amongst the people of Nombela.

The Kosas are scattered all over the show. They are scattered in towns & in other places of employment. You would find them speaking in English rather than in Sicoso. You would find them working for money rather than for cattle; also banking accounts, eoven, and houses in towns instead of owning oxen for racing and large herds of cattle. You would find them racing bicycles instead of oxen. They have now married one wife instead of many wives; they do wander about with single women and there are no such things as concubines. The young men & girls are away in Training Institutions instead of Intonyane & Abakweta dances. You would find these scholars playing Cricket & Tennis instead of attending dances, affrays etc.

The girls attend sewing classes instead of moulding pots, dancing & fetching fire-wood.

all these different training of the young people serve to cover up all those different sports & plays of the young in the olden days.

You would find all the scholars speaking in the English language while in School & in Sports.

On the occasions the young are dressed in their best European clothes because there are no more of those olden times garments, bangles etc. and even those that can be found are not recognized as anything. Everywhere where there is British Administration the official language is English; they wash with soap instead of wet cow-dung & spit; plates & dishes are washed with water & wiped with a cloth instead of heating it on a fire to dry up or giving it to a dog to lick it up. People take their meals on tables there are no more eating mats. People sleep with blankets there are no more hide-blankets & game-blankets. People sleep on beds.
