The Joanna Briggs Institute (JBI) **Comprehensive Systematic Review Training Program** enables participants to learn how to conduct robust reviews of different evidence types from quantitative and qualitative research, narrative and text, in order to provide the strongest possible evidence base to inform decisions. We invite you to participate in this world-class systematic review training program, which incorporates both theory and hands on experience. Throughout the program you will learn how to develop a focussed question, search for relevant literature, appraise and synthesise evidence arising from research. By the end of the program you will have a completed protocol and be ready to commence your review!

Participants who successfully complete the program can become Certified Reviewers. Certified Reviewers are accredited for a period of two years as authors in the JBI Database of Systematic Reviews and Implementation Reports (JBI-SRIR), a refereed online journal, the content of which is indexed in Embase, Scopus, Mosby's Index (Elsevier), CINAHL (EBSCO) and MEDLINE.
