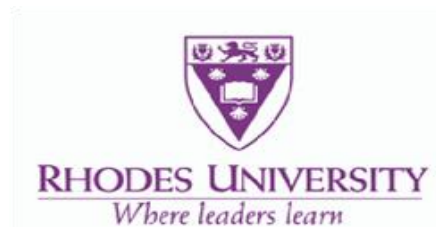
TRAINING ON DATA COLLECTION, MANAGEMENT AND ANALYSIS FOR EVIDENCE-BASED DECISION-MAKING
