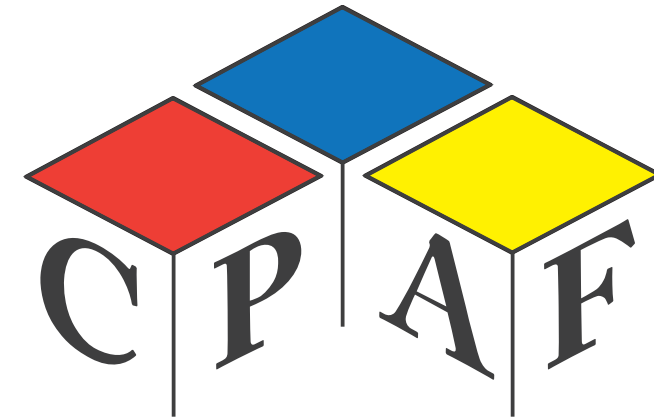

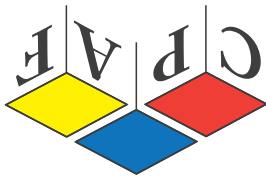

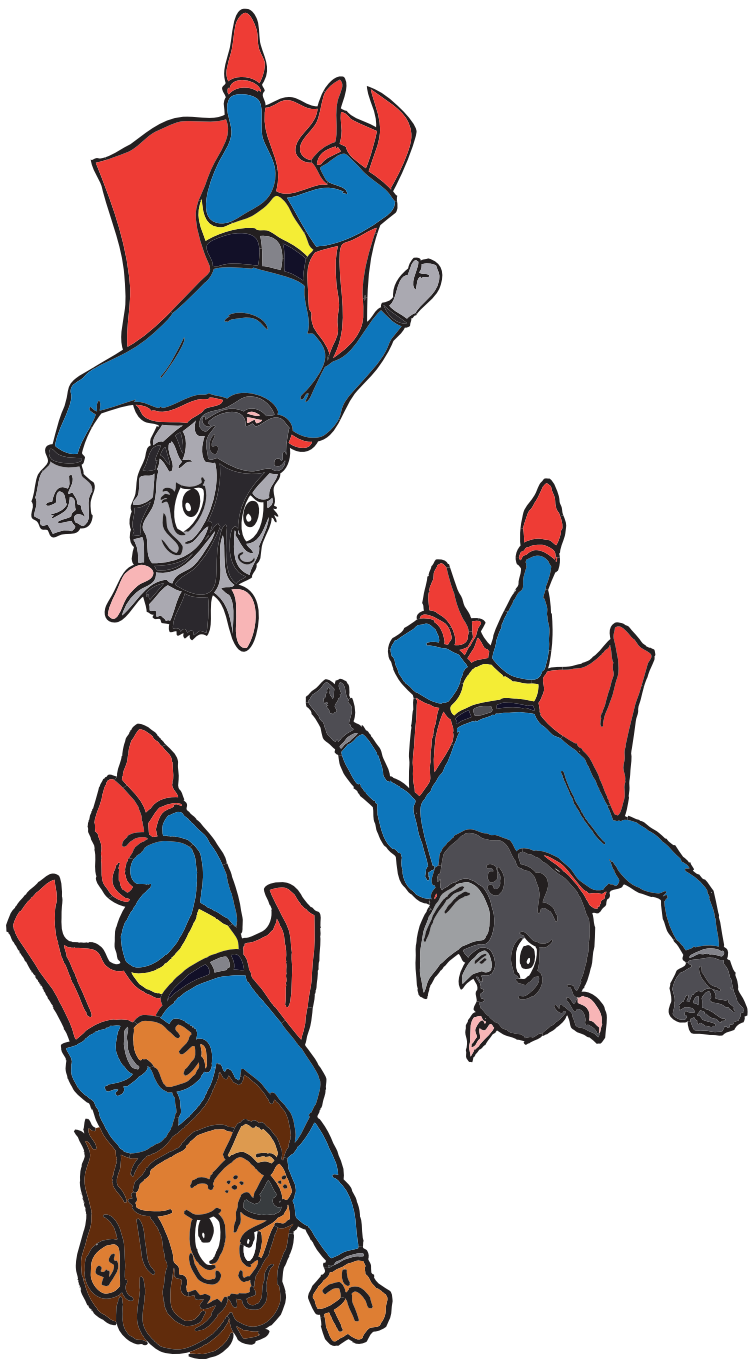


CPAF meets once a month to discuss pertinent issues and campaigns in child safety in Grahamstown and works to offer support to professionals, young people and activists working in child safety.
