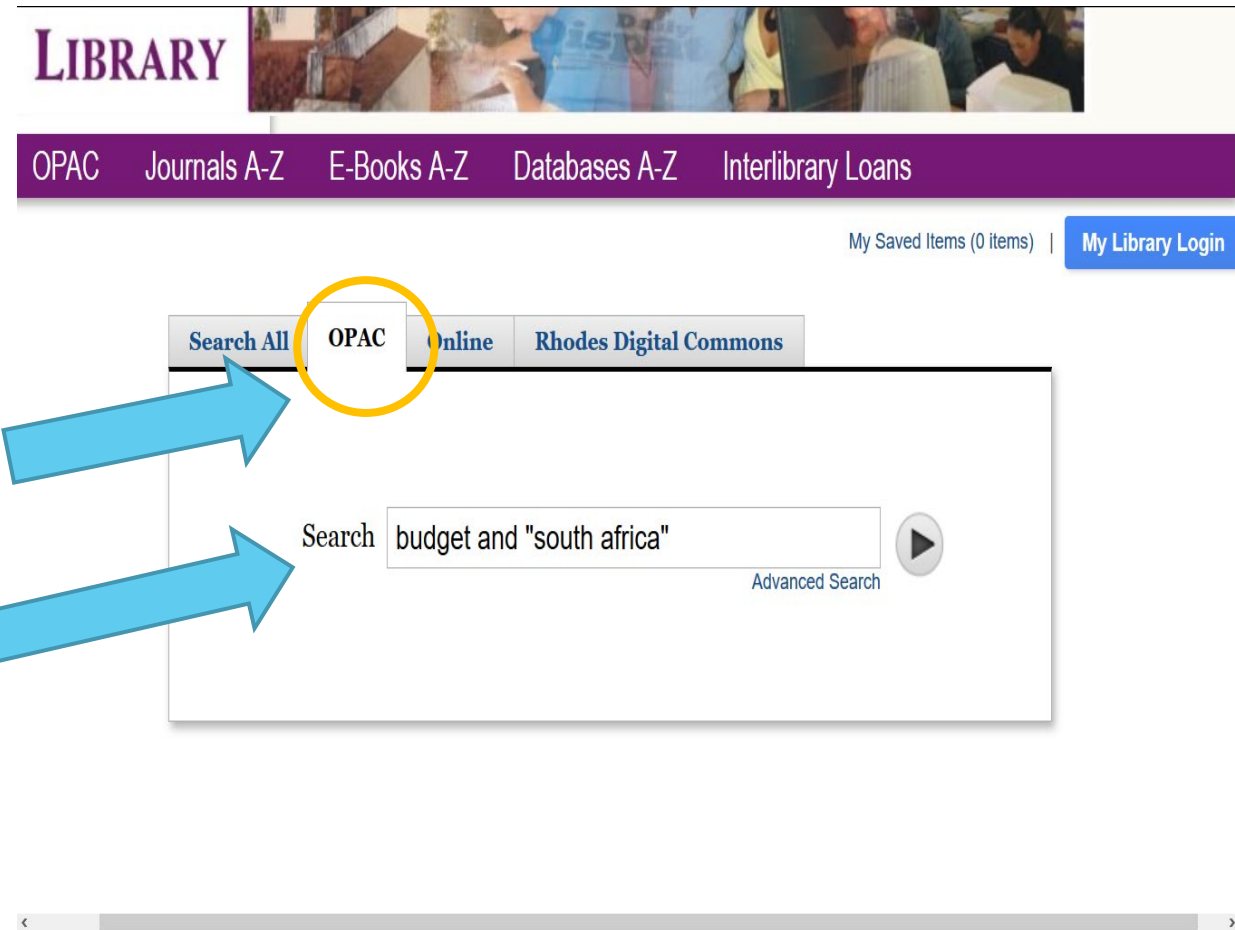

Searching for an e-book on a topic:

Search All is a discovery platform searching across all RUL resources

- Select OPAC (for Books, Print Materials & eBooks)
- Enter Keywords (Search Terms)



Search All: Finding e-Books - Results

- ▶ Number of results (254)

- ▶ Rhodes shares **Search All** with other academic libraries in the Eastern Cape, so you need to refine the results to see only RU items (click on more).

- ▶ Then select RU Online resources and click “Apply”




