Over the decades, Flanagan Scholars have taken up leadership positions in many formerly male-dominated fields of endeavour. They have become top lawyers, global communicators, ground-breaking medical scientists, language lecturers, philosophers, journalists, literary agents, musicians, psychologists and economists working to benefit developing countries.

Application procedure:

The following documents are to be submitted to **pgfunding@ru.ac.za** as a SINGLE PDF document, saved as "Your Surname P&M Flanagan Scholarship Application":

- **Letter of motivation:** The motivation should include:
 - 1) Why you plan to study at an international university.
 - 2) What you plan to do upon completion of your Masters or PhD.
 - 3) Your intended Research Focus.
 - 4) Which university you wish to enrol with, and why you have selected that university.

- Detailed ACADEMIC CV including email contact details of three ACADEMIC referees one of which must be a Head of Department or Dean
- A full academic transcript, certified.
- Certified **ID copy**.
