

RU LOAN APPLICATION PROCEEDURE 2022


The online application process is via the Telegram app. If you don't have it, then you can download it from your App Store.



Please note, we do require supporting documentation and the required documents are listed when you are ready to upload the documents in the form of a checklist. For your convenience, the attached PDF is a brief guide to assist. You can also provide a covering letter if more detail is needing to be conveyed. Include brief plans after studying as well, in the motivation.

DOCUMENTATION		Please tick
1.	One certified copy of student's S.A. ID document (or proof of application or proof of SA Permanent Residency - passports and birth certificates are not acceptable).	
2.	If you have studied before coming to Rhodes please provide academic transcripts of your previous University.	
3.	If your parents/guardians are deceased or divorced – provide a certified copy of the death certificate or divorce decree (including details of any maintenance payments). A sworn affidavit may be provided.	
4.	If parents/guardians are employed – provide the most recent pay slip for each person or a letter from the employer, giving full details of gross income and all other benefits, including nett salary.	
5.	If parents/guardian are unemployed – a sworn affidavit signed by the unemployed person before a commissioner of oaths proving unemployment must be provided.	
6.	If either parents/guardian are pensioners – a certified copy of their pension slip must be provided. If your parents/guardian receives a state pension and slips are not available, a sworn affidavit indicating the amount received must be provided.	
7.	If either of your parents/guardian 1) works in the informal sector: provide a sworn affidavit with estimated monthly income. 2) own any business: provide an audited business statement with assets, liabilities, income and expenditure.	
8.	If your spouse/live-in partner has indicated that they are employed or if you are on study leave – supply a copy of the most recent pay slips and Study Leave forms where applicable.	
9.	If you have indicated that you are self supporting, please provide proof (eg: pay slips (if applicable), bank statements, proof of income from investments, savings etc to show source of income for the year of study).	
10.	If you have a sibling that is also a student please provide proof of their registration.	
11.	If you have dependants other than your spouse/live in partner, please provide details.	
12.	You must provide id copies for all independent's as mentioned in Section 4 above, as well as id copies of your parents / guardians who is working	



Then you will work through each question which autosaves as you complete a question




Once the last set of documents and questions are answered, then you end up at a menu where you can check your application status:
