### The Rhodes University Prestigious Scholarships 2024

**Closing Date: 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023**

#### Funded Levels and amounts:

Honours: R120 000

Masters: R120 000

Doctoral: R130 000

Scholarships for postgraduate studies in any Faculty at Rhodes University.

#### Eligibility

- Academic merit (> 65%), although other factors, such as demonstrated excellent service to the community, could be considered.
- Younger than 36 years of age at the time of application.
- **Open to ALL citizenships.**

#### Duration of Funding

**Honours:** One year only.

**Masters:** Initially for one year, renewable based on a satisfactory progress report. Maximum 2 years only.

**Doctoral:** Initially for one year, renewable based on a satisfactory progress report. Maximum 3 years only.

#### Conditions

Full-time attendance at Rhodes University.

Masters and Doctoral only: Compulsory Tutoring Assistance of not more than 6 hours a week, without remuneration.

#### Application Procedure

##### 1. FIRST TIME APPLICANTS

Please submit the following documents, **as a single PDF document labelled "Surname\_RUPG Scholarship"**:

- A covering letter indicating intended degree and subjects or field of research.
- A completed application form (complete with all the required supporting documents listed in Section D)
- Detailed ACADEMIC Curriculum Vitae
- Contact details of three academic referees (including email addresses)
- Certified full academic transcript
- Certified copy of your ID
- Evidence of communication with a supervisor or prospective supervisor at Rhodes University.

##### 2. RENEWAL APPLICANTS

Please submit the following documents, **as a single PDF labelled "Surname\_RUPG Scholarship Renewal"**:

- A covering letter stating the renewal request.
- Progress report from applicant.
- Progress report from supervisor.

**No late or incomplete applications will be considered.**
