- E. Certificate of participation would only be issued to participants who are present for at least 70% of the Workshop duration.
- F. Workshop fees are to be paid through the bank. Only bank tellers would be received for registration.
- F. Both entry for participation and submission of abstract for lectures (presentations) should be made to the workshop registrar at least 48 hours before date of presentation.
- G. Participants are to vacate camp on the last day of the workshop (usually Saturday) to make room for incoming participants for the next session. Failure to vacate immediately may be viewed as an indication by participant to continue in the new session for which such participant is expected to register anew.
