




# 5 monkeys in the small tree.




Minky Monkey moans.

There are too <u>many</u> monkeys in this small tree. There are <u>no</u> monkeys in the big tree.




Minky Monkey moans. There are still <u>more</u> monkeys in this small tree and <u>less</u> in the big tree. What do you think will happen next?




Minky Monkey still moans.

There are still <u>many</u> monkeys in the small tree and <u>less</u> in the big tree.


Is Minky right? What do you think will happen next?




Minky Monkey moans. I am all alone. I am lonely. There are <u>many</u> monkeys having fun in the big tree. What do you think will happen next?
