



5 monkeys in the small tree.



Minky Monkey moans.


There are too many monkeys in this small tree.

There are no monkeys in the big tree.




Minky Monkey moans.

There are still more monkeys in this small tree and less in the big tree. What do you think will happen next?




Minky Monkey still moans.

There are still many monkeys in the small tree and less in the big tree. Is Minky right? What do you think will happen next?




Minky Monkey still moans. There are 2 of us in this small tree. There are less monkeys here than in the big tree there. Is Minky right? What do you think will happen next?




Minky Monkey moans. I am all alone. I am lonely. There are many monkeys having fun in the big tree. What do you think will happen next?
