






Minky Monkey still moans: There are two of us in this small tree. There are less monkeys in this small tree than in the big tree.






Five monkeys having fun in the **big** tree.

Ask children to find the

- numerals 0 to 5,
- number words zero to five,
- comparative words more, less,
 big and small.

Tips for using this book:

- Talk about what might happen next, before you turn over each page.
- Draw attention to the key words and numerals on each page.
- Talk about the combinations of numbers (5 &0; 4&1; 3&2) that together make 5.
- After the story, talk about what happened in the story.
- Ask children to re-tell the story.
- Ask children to pretend read the story.
